For a number of reasons, parents may choose to have their child receive an educational program at home or from outside of the district. Consistent with the *School Act* and the *Distance Education Order*, the Board is committed to providing quality programs for these students, as well as for adult learners who wish to continue their education. Methods of delivery include both paper-based instruction and online courses. A blended instructional model is used, except where distance precludes this.
