



2010 Summer Learning

Surrey School District summer classes and targeted programs focus on student achievement

Full Credit Summer School (80 hours) – July 5, 2010 to August 6, 2010 (no classes August 2, 2010)

–Grades 10, 11 and 12 four-credit courses

- Offered at Earl Marriott, North Surrey and Princess Margaret
- Students do not require a referral for full credit summer school courses
- Students register on-line in First Class or on the district web site
- Audit is no longer available
- Registration will open March 29, 2010
- Open to International/out-of-province students - \$800/course

Remedial Summer School (40 hours) – July 5, 2010 to July 30, 2010

–Grades 8, 9, 10 and 11 partial-credit courses

- Offered at Earl Marriott and Queen Elizabeth
- Students who did not pass a core academic course and received between 40% and 49%
- Students with under 40% require a written referral from their home school
- Students will receive a pass after successful completion of the course
- Students register on-line in First Class or on the district web site
- Audit is no longer available
- Registration will open March 29, 2010
- Open to International/out-of-province students - \$400/course

Transitions (40 hours) – July 5, 2010 to July 21, 2010

- District program for students currently in Grade 7
- Offered at all secondary schools
- Students are recommended by their elementary school
- Elementary schools register students by sending in registration forms
- Deadline for submission of registration forms will be May 7, 2010
- Not open to International/out-of-province students

Literacy/Numeracy Programs for Struggling Learners (40 hours)

Session 1 – July 5, 2010 – July 16, 2010

Session 2 – July 19, 2010 – July 30, 2010

- Developed for students currently in Grades K – 6
- Offered at community-centralized 'hub' schools chosen by the district based on local community needs
- Students are recommended by their elementary home school
- Elementary schools register students by sending in registration forms
- Deadline for submission of registration forms will be May 7, 2010
- Not open to International students/out-of-province students
