SFU Surrey Entrance Award – Description and Details

Simon Fraser University is very pleased to announce the availability of a series of \$2,000 SFU Surrey Entrance Awards to high school students in British Columbia.

These awards are available to students who plan to begin their studies at our Surrey campus in one of the following five, first-year programs: Systems One (Applied Sciences), Explorations (Arts and Social Sciences), BusOne (Business Administration), TechOne (Communication, Art and Technology) or Science Year One. Students who apply for direct admission to Software Systems (Computing Science), Mechatronic Systems Engineering (Engineering Science), Criminology, World Literature, Business Administration, Interactive Arts and Technology, Education (BGS), Mathematics, or Management and Systems Science at the Surrey campus are also eligible to apply for the awards. Students who expect to achieve academic averages between 80 and 90 percent are encouraged to apply. High school applicants with 90 percent or greater will be considered for a \$3,500 Summit Scholarship while high school applicants with 95% or greater will be considered for a \$5,000 Academic Excellence Scholarship.

Careful consideration will be given to applicants who demonstrate a commitment to their school and wider community, who exhibit leadership, and who show an academic interest in arts and social sciences, business administration, computing science, engineering science, education, interactive arts and technology, mathematics, or science.

To apply for the SFU Surrey Entrance Award students must,

- complete and sign an application form
- have a school official complete a referee form on their behalf
- provide a one or two page resume of achievements and activities
- submit a 500 word essay that outlines their interest in one or more of the programs at the SFU Surrey campus, and why they would be a worthy recipient
- provide two copies of their transcripts or high school grade reports that include grade 11 and 12 course marks to date

All of the above documents must be fastened together and submitted in a single large envelope; either to the student's school representative, or directly to Simon Fraser University Surrey and be postmarked no later than February 28, 2012. School representatives who have collected applications on behalf of their students must forward the application packages to SFU Surrey no later than March 7, 2012.

SFU Surrey Entrance Award – Application Form

General Criteria

Applicants must be Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, or Landed Immigrants. All Entrance Award applicants should have academic averages between 80 and 90 percent. Careful consideration will be given to applicants that demonstrate an academic interest in Arts and Social Sciences, Business, Computing Science, Engineering Science, Education, Interactive Arts and Technology, Mathematics, or Science. Students that show a strong commitment to their school and wider community will be given preference.

Step 1

- Go to www.applybc.ca before February 28 and apply for admission (for information on how to apply or to get help with your application, visit www.surrey.sfu.ca/undergraduate/admission)
- Self-report your grades and pay the application fee to be considered for admission

Step 2

Submit this paper application form and all supporting documents to your school representative or to SFU Surrey directly, no later than February 28, 2012

What Happens Next

- Your school will gather together and forward your Entrance Award application to Enrollment Services, Simon Fraser University Surrey.
- Selected award recipients will be notified before the end of May

Fasten together and submit the following in a single large envelope to your school representative:

- This application form, original or photocopied, completed and signed
- One referee form returned in a sealed envelope. The referee form should be completed by a teacher or school official who knows you well.
- A one or two page resume of achievements and activities
- A 500 word essay that outlines your interest in one or more of the programs at SFU Surrey, and why you would be a worthy recipient
- Two copies of your transcripts that include your grade 11 and 12 course marks to date
