Board adopts new district calendar and common non-instructional days

As you know, the Surrey Board of Education invited your input on changes proposed for the 2009-2010 school calendar as a potential response to budget challenges. The proposal was described in my letter to parents and guardians on April 27 this year. The board is grateful for the many thoughtful letters from the community, and the views and suggestions expressed.

The majority of respondents support the proposed changes. After considering input from parents/guardians, staff members and other stakeholders, the board approved district-wide changes to school calendars at its public board meeting on May 28.

The board has adopted a common local 2009-2010 school calendar for the district, as described below:

Six fewer days of instruction (with an increase of instructional time to make up the six days):

- One day: November 12, 2009 (Thursday after Remembrance Day)
- Five days: March 15 – 19, 2010 (the week following the provincial school calendar spring break week)

District-wide non-instructional days (or "Pro-D" days):

- September 28, 2009
- October 23, 2009
- November 13, 2009
- February 5, 2010
- May 7, 2010
- May 31, 2010

Secondary school days in the district are approximately 7 hours long, and include:

- 320 minutes of instructional time (an increase of 11 minutes per day on average),
- class change times,
- one lunch break of 50 minutes (may vary slightly by school),

School daily office hours are at least 7.5 hours.

The Surrey Board of Education thanks all staff and families for taking the time to make their views known on the 2009-2010 school calendar changes.
