



Proposed Boundary Move for September 2012

Frost Road to Woodland Park

A school boundary change is being proposed for a portion of Frost Road Elementary School's catchment as identified in the accompanying map.

Currently, the outlined area is part of the Frost Road Elementary School catchment. The proposal is to make this area part of the Woodland Park Elementary catchment. The change will support objectives for:

- More efficient use of existing space at schools;
- Filling empty classrooms;
- Reducing projected overcrowding and portables; and
- Balancing future enrolment growth between schools.

While no plan can perfectly accommodate all goals and differing interests, after consideration of various scenarios, the new boundaries achieve the closest balance.

Elementary School Boundary Change Implications

The boundary change is proposed to be "phased in" and will **not** affect any **current** students attending Frost Road Elementary or Woodland Park Elementary. Current students and siblings of current students will attend the same school. Any new students (students who moved into the area, or children who become of school age in 2012) would attend Woodland Park Elementary starting September 2012.

Alternatives

New students can choose to attend any school they wish, *if space is available*, by submitting an "out-of-catchment" application form (available at any school) to their chosen school. Names are placed on a waiting list at the school in the order received.
