

## **PSI SELECTIONS FORM**

*Electronic access to the Post-Secondary Institutions Selection Form*

### **What does the PSI Selection Form do?**

*Completion of this form allows the Ministry of Education to release the student's marks to identified Post-Secondary Institutions chosen by the student.*

#### **STEP 1**

Get your PEN (Provincial Education Number) and have it ready. It is on your report cards in a box underneath your name.

#### **STEP 2**

Go to the Student Secure Web of the Ministry of Education online.

#### **STEP 3**

Access your account. You must choose to either:

A) Create an account

You will be asked to provide your name, birthdate, PEN, and email address(es).

Or

B) Login to your pre-existing account.

Note: This is the same process to access your provincial exam results so you may have already created an account to find past exam results.

**Once you have entered the Student Secure Web, you will follow the procedures as outlined by the Ministry of Education on the following pages. READ CAREFULLY!!!!!!!!!!**

#### **IMPORTANT:**

Students wishing to have their marks forwarded in the early admission transfer to BC Electronic PSIs and the Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC) must submit their selections by April 30<sup>th</sup>.
