

Rewriting optional exams for students who wish to improve their optional exam mark to qualify for scholarship (pre-September 2011 graduates), or to improve their final mark on Transcript of Grades:

- a set of optional Grade 12 Provincial Examinations will be made available to schools for students who wish to rewrite to improve their results
- the optional exams will be available to rewrite from November 1, 2011 until June 30, 2012
- the one year rewrite rule applies: (for example, students who wrote in January 2011 must rewrite by January 2012)
- students whose rewrite mark is higher than their original mark will receive an updated transcript by mail within 6 to 8 weeks
- for language exams, the listening/speaking components will not be available for retake. Students may rewrite the written portion and the listening/speaking components from their previous exam attempt will be blended with the rewrite.

Rewriting old Math 10 exams for students who wish to improve their exam mark to qualify for the new Provincial Examination Scholarship Program:

- old Math 10 exams (Principles of Mathematics 10, Essentials of Mathematics 10, and Applications of Mathematics 10) will be offered in all exam sessions until August 2012
- students may rewrite once only over the course of this school year, and must have already written the exam at least once (no first-time writing of these old Math 10 exams)
- students who have already written any Grade 10 or 11 exam twice prior to September
